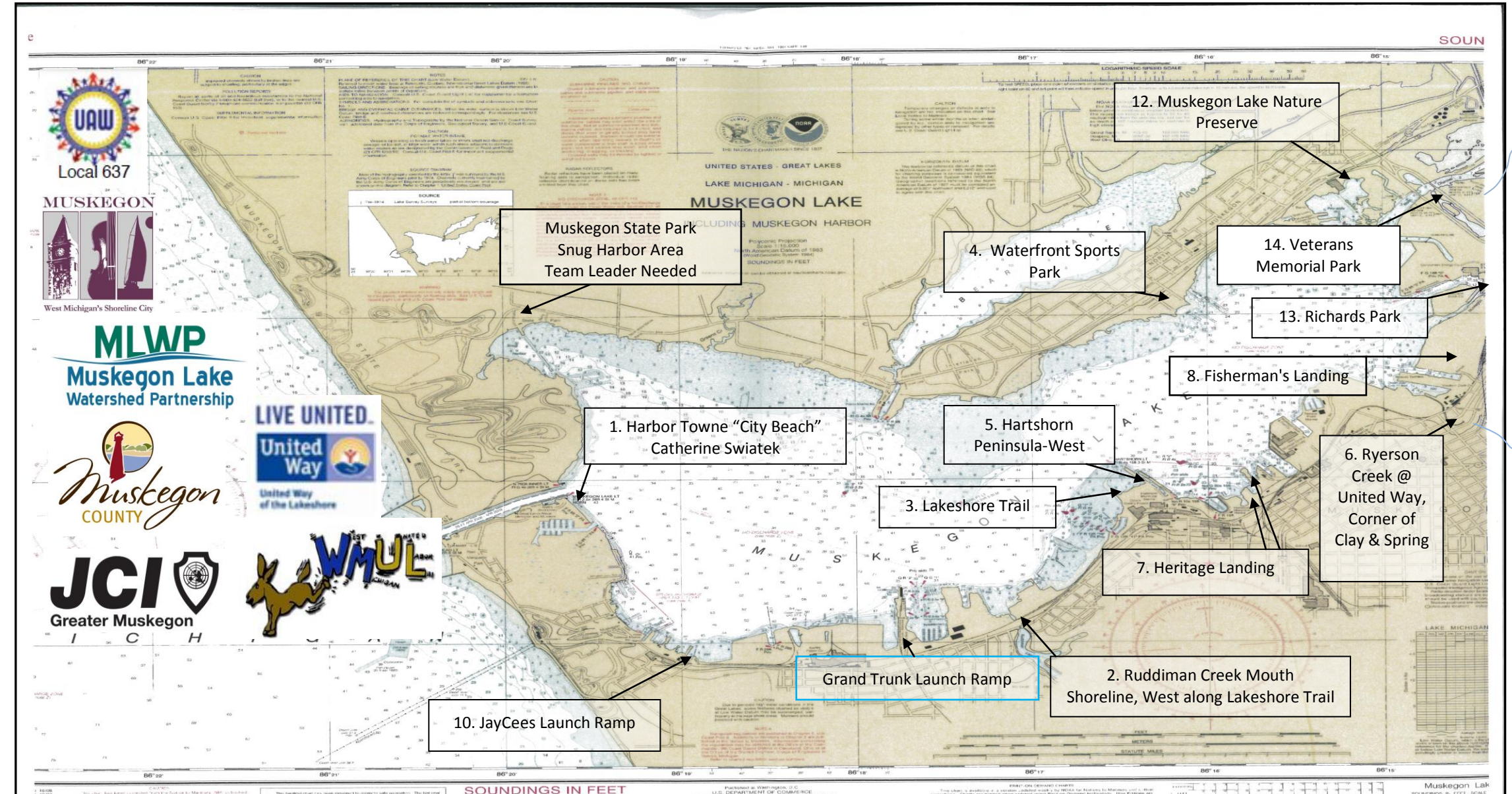

12. Muskegon Lake Nature Preserve	Gale Nobes	Parking Lot on Lake St., N. Muskegon	Invasive Plant Debris Mgt/Trash along shoreline
13. Richards Park	Wayne Groesbeck	Parking Lot at end of Ottawa Street	River is high. Dangerous. Do not enter.
14. Veterans Memorial Park	Kathy Evans	Parking Lot on northbound Causeway	Trash in native plant buffer around south pond
